Being in the ALA Elementary DI program is a privilege and an amazing educational opportunity for your child to be able to be challenged and ultimately be totally bilingual in reading, writing, and speaking Spanish.

Being a parent of a child in this program requires commitment, active involvement, and dedication on your part as parents. Here are some of the basic requirements:

- Upon confirmation of acceptance, parents must attend mandatory new student/parent DI orientation meeting.
- Attend both parent teacher conferences in the school year.
- Commit to providing your 40 hours of parental service/volunteer time throughout the school year (Money can be given in lieu of service at \$7.50 per hour)
- Commit to consistently working with your child on their homework each night.
- The expectation is that students are punctual and consistently attending school.
- The expectation is that the student adheres to the school and classroom rules and tries his/her best to behave appropriately.

If it is determined by the teachers and administration that your student is frequently out of compliance with the DI requirements, we reserve the right to move your student to a different class.
